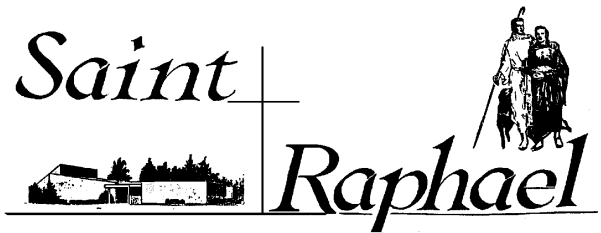

**Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion C
 April 14, 2019**

"I tell you, I shall not eat it again until there is fulfillment in the kingdom of God."

My dear Friends, 40 days of preparation for this week! The Lenten season of sacrifice and self-denial is about to come to an end. This Holy Week is the most critical time in our liturgical year. I hope you are ready to celebrate this important time. Have you scheduled these significant days in your calendar?

What I am saying, Holy Week is most definitely a very sacred time of the year, for it is now that we will commemorate and remember the last week of Jesus' life on this earth. These are the days leading up to the great Easter Feast. The greatest focus of the week is the passion (suffering) and Resurrection of Jesus Christ and the events that led up to it. We are going to start this wonderful week with Palm Sunday, which marks Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem. I am going to bless the palms, and we are going to enter in procession to the church, and we are going to hear a very long Gospel that helps us to understand what is going to happen in this week.

Remember that these three days just before Easter. On Holy Thursday, we reenact the Lord's Supper, which He shared with His apostles on the night He was betrayed and arrested. Holy Thursday is my favorite day in the Holy Week because it is one of the most beautiful liturgies of the entire year. At the Mass, I will wash the feet of twelve men, just as Jesus did. Also on this night, priest all over the world will renew their sacred vows, in the diocese of Gaylord we do it on Tuesday, this is because, at the Last Supper, Jesus instituted not only the Mass (Eucharist) but also the ministerial priesthood. We are going to have adoration until 12!

On Good Friday, the day of the crucifixion and death of our Lord, we have the veneration of the cross. We are going to have this service at 3 pm (the hour He is believed to have died), We go forward and kiss the Cross to show honor and respect for Christ's sacrifice for our sake. There is no consecration of the Eucharist on this day, and the Communion we receive will be from the night before, which has been reserved in the tabernacle.

We will finish these three days with the Holy Saturday vigil. We keep watching for the expectant rising of Our Savior. By paying the price for our sins on the Cross, Jesus gained for us our eternal salvation, and heaven was opened once more. In this night, will be received in full communion with our Church 3 young people who have spent months of preparation for this day. It is a joyous occasion.

Holy Week is a time to clear our schedules of unnecessary activities. Our minds and hearts should be fixed on Jesus and what He did for us. Let us bear the Cross and be with Jesus in these important days when He offered his suffering for you and for me.
