**Tenth Sunday in Ordinary Time B  
 June 10, 2018**

**"They said, "He is out of his mind."**

My Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, we finished our Easter season and all the beautiful solemnities and feast that we celebrate during this time. Now, we are in the second part of the ordinary time. I found a great quote about this time, "You are all we have. You give us what we need. Living the ordinary time, our lives are in your hands of God." Is it not great to feel the company of our God in our lives? You know that our ordinary time is the biggest time during the liturgical year we celebrated in 2 parts. First: between Christmas and Lent. Second: between Easter and Advent. During this time we Celebrate life and teachings of Christ." Have you thought about your routinely life? What do you do every day? How do you do it?

For me this ordinary time is teaching me to look for God's will in the ordinary things of life. I read this, "Live every day as your last day, because someday are you going to be right." God is calling us to live every single day in his ways; God is calling us to become saints in this moment, in this place, and in this time. God promised to give us his grace to strive for sanctity in the everyday world.

I found this quote from Proverbs 3,6, "Seek God's will in all you do, and He will show you the path to take." How many times in your life feel that God's will too much that God is asking us. But, Jesus taught them a beautiful lesson when He told them, "Who are my mother and my brothers? And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother." Remember, "Everything that grows begins small," and God chose us from the beginning to be his instruments of salvation for many people. God has prepared us and given us what we need to show his love and mercy in this world and He promised us to be with us until the end of the world. We only need to trust and listen His words and do his will in our lives.
