The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity May 27, 2018

"Therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit."

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, in these Sundays our church is helping us to think a little more about our beliefs and our Church calls us to pay attention to central mysteries of our faith. Today, we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, this is a mystery, and this is a great occasion to know a little more about one God in three persons. Have you ever thought about this mystery? Have you read about the Most Holy Trinity? I have studied for many years about our church and about God, and I remember that for a whole semester we have in the seminary a class about this mystery. Every single year when our Church celebrates this Solemnity I have the chance to understand a little bet more how wonderful our God is with us.

We heard in our Gospel today, "The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they all saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted." Even though these disciples say our Lord and worshiped Him, they doubted! I feel that most of the time I am like these disciples, always doubting about our God. I would like to think, but perhaps I am presuming too much, that I have to know everything about God in order to believe in Him. My limited, creaturely mind cannot understand completely about this mystery. But, I can experience his love for me and for humanity.

My personal experience of love, of deep friendship, might give me the spark of a glimmer of understanding of God and specially today about this mystery. I know about this beautiful community of three persons in one God when I love and experience my friend's love for me. In loving one another there is the delight, the beauty, of bonding together, of being there for each other.

When I reflect on this mystery, God...three persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Their life is a communion of love. A communion of love where there is a divine collaboration between the Heavenly Father, 'through our Lord Jesus Christ, His Son, who lives and reigns with him in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, forever and ever.' When I see my friends, when I see these parishes working together I can see this mystery alive and among us. Divine collaboration!

This Solemnity is helping us to understand that our generous God has created us human beings with one beautiful purpose, that God who does not need our company actually wants us to enjoy his company, here and now, in our present earthly existence and this place and in this time.

Stewardship by the Book - The Gospel today is sometimes called "the Gospel in miniature" because it so concisely sums up the Gospel message. In even more condensed form, "God loved... God gave..." it is the paradigm for stewardship - we give because we love.

Stewardship Reflections -

"The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ..." - ROMANS 8:16-17

If we are heirs to the kingdom of God, shouldn't we work to build up His kingdom? Shouldn't we be good stewards of our inheritance, using our time in prayer, our talent in charitable works and our treasure to care for the Church that God has left to us? Our Church is a treasured heirloom from God. Do we treat it that way?

Family Perspective - In today's gospel Jesus commands, "Teach them to carry out everything I have commanded you." This command is meant for every Christian. In light of this command, parenting is not only the most difficult task a person can take on, it is also one of the most apostolic and missionary tasks. Jesus commands all parents to teach their children "all that I have commanded you."

Promise to Protect; Pledge to Heal - In an effort to protect all children and to promote healing, the Diocese of Gaylord encourages victims of child abuse or neglect to report the matter. In fact, many professionals are required by Michigan State law to report suspected abuse or neglect of a child or minor. Individuals should contact their local office of the Department of Human Services.
