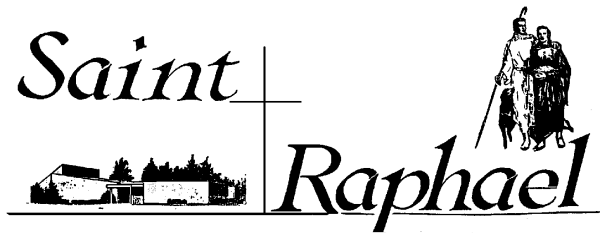

**"It is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how."**

**FAMILY PERSPECTIVE** - Parenting is a lot like the story of the farmer in the Gospel parable today. All growth is the Lord's work. We have no control over the process. **Protecting Our Children** - In accordance with the Diocese of Gaylord Policy for the **Protection of Children**, "any cleric, religious, employee or other person acting with authority of the Church of the Diocese of Gaylord who knows, or has reason to believe, that an incident of sexual abuse of a minor has occurred shall comply with state reporting requirements, specifically the Michigan Child Protection Law and to the Bishop's Review Board, except for those communications that are canonically privileged." In addition to the Michigan mandatory reporting requirements of clergy, teachers and other professionals, anyone who suspects a child is being abused in any way is encouraged to contact their local Department of Human Services (DHS) to file a report. If the allegation involves an employee or volunteer in the service of the Church in the Diocese of Gaylord, contact Tom Tenerovicz at 1-800-727-5147 ext 3534 or 989-705-3534 following notification of the local DHS.
